Managers view

Portfolio overview

The portfolio tracks the FTSE/JSE Capped Swix All Share Index by investing in the underlying equities and by maintaining a low exposure to cash. Net flows to and from the portfolio are matched with trades on a daily basis. The portfolio minimises trading costs and therefore uses FTSE/JSE Capped Swix 40 futures as and when appropriate.

The portfolio is rebalanced on a quarterly basis in line with any changes in the FTSE/JSE Capped Swix All Share Index and its constituents will mirror the index as close as practical to minimise the tracking error.

There were seven index constituent changes during the quarter – Trustco, Balwin, Caxton and Clientele were replaced by Libstar, Mix Telematics and Vivo Energy. The biggest weight changes occurred in Distell and Sasol that were down-weighted and in Old Mutual and Naspers were up-weighted due to changes in their respective shares in issue in the benchmark.



Portfolio positioning

The FTSE/JSE Capped Swix All Share Index declined 1.7% over the quarter and increased by 0.4% over the year to 30 September 2018. Over the past three months the biggest contribution to the index performance came from Sasol which delivered a return of 8.9%. The biggest detractor came from Naspers which was down 12.4% over the quarter.

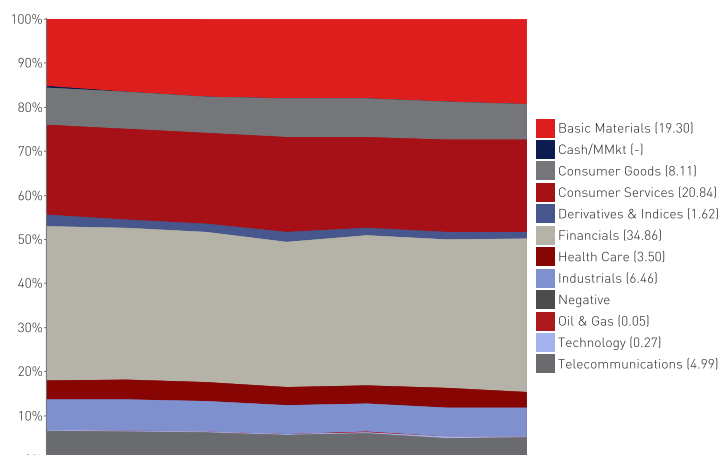
The portfolio performed in line with its benchmark over the quarter ending 30 September 2018.

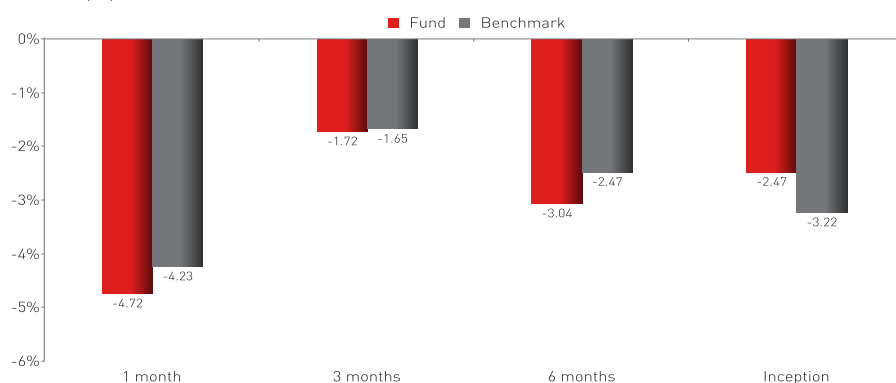
