#### Managers view

##### Portfolio overview

The portfolio ended the quarter with 81.8% hedged equity exposure, 2% in unhedged equity and 16.2% in cash.

Relative to the benchmark the portfolio has:

- A small overweight exposure to the resources sector. Within the sector we have an underweight exposure to speciality chemicals and an overweight exposure to the general mining sector.
- A small underweight exposure to the industrial sector. The portfolio has an overweight exposure to the apparel retailer's industry and an underweight exposure to the mobile telecommunications sector.
- A small overweight exposure to the financial sector. The portfolio has an overweight exposure to the banking industry.



##### Portfolio positioning

The holding in Truworthe and Motus was sold out during the quarter as they exited the index. The exposure to Amplats and PSG were increased during the quarter. There were no major shares in issue changes at quarter end.

The top-five overweight exposures are:

- Absa

- Bidcorp

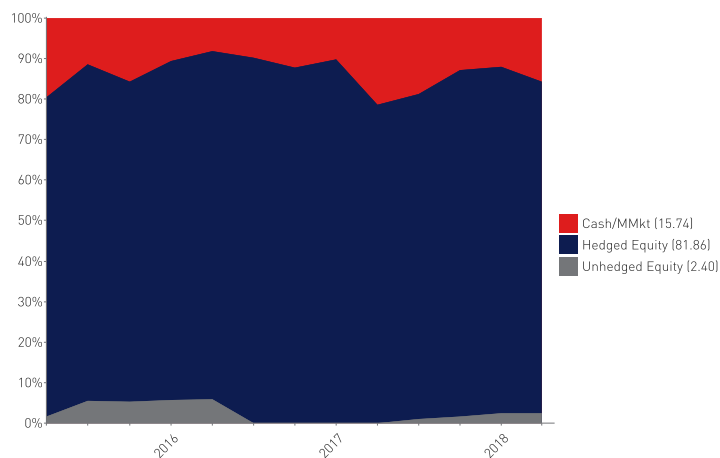

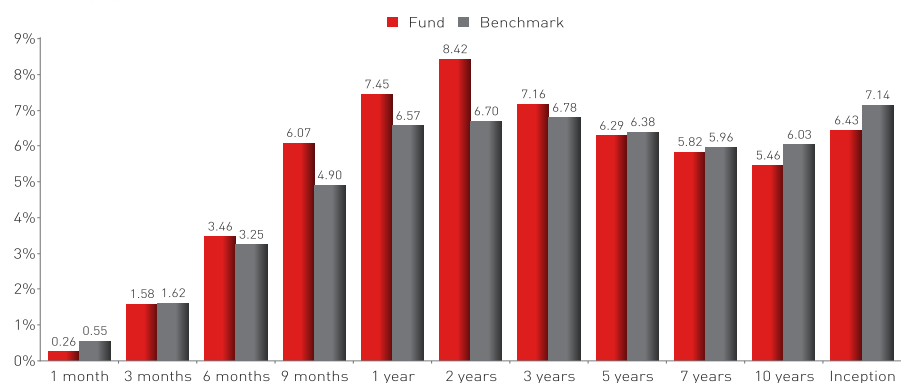

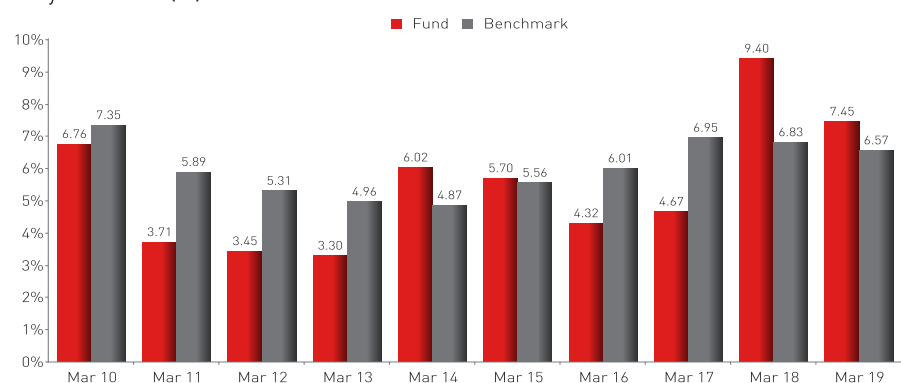
